

Clinical Toxicology Course

The Australian Clinical Toxicology group is running an internet based online distance learning course in **Clinical Toxicology** which will commence in **April 2011**.

The course is suitable for;

Medical practitioners who for see clinical toxicology to be part of their career path. Course material is delivered to a Diploma or Masters standard.

Students would require;

Regular internet access a computer and a level of English comprehension in reading that is sufficient to read journal literature and English fluency in writing that will allow contribution to the online discussions that will be part of the course

The course is offering a **limited number of free enrollments** to eligible students. Preference will be given to students from countries with developing or emerging economies.

The course will be run over 18 months and cover the significant areas in acute clinical toxicology

Student selection would be based upon the student being able to demonstrate a need for training.
